Local Political Party Leader Launches New Book For ADULTS ONLY

WEST PALM BEACH, FL (October 31, 2007)– Star Group International announces that Sid Dinerstein’s new book, *ADULTS ONLY: For People Who Love Their Country More Than Their Party* will be released to the public in Fall, 2007. “Grow up,” Dinerstein writes. The biggest problem with American politics, he says, is the “blame game”– played with the sole objective of scoring points and not solving problems. “Too many people love their political party more than their country,” he writes. In *ADULTS ONLY*, Dinerstein urges everyone to put partisan politics aside and change their attitudes to change how we conduct politics. “Democracy is not a spectator’s sport.”

The mission outlined in *ADULTS ONLY* is for Americans to take back their government– a fight waged between political insiders (elected officials) and political outsiders (we the people). With wit and wisdom, Dinerstein explains how. It’s simple, he explains – by amending the Constitution to require term limits, a balanced budget and English as the official language. He also offers no-nonsense solutions to big issues plaguing the country such as Terrorism, Immigration, Healthcare, Social Security and more. For example, when it comes to dealing with the Terrorism threat, we’ve doubled the gas prices ultimately putting more money in the terrorists’ coffers. Sid’s solution is that the US becomes a leading producer of domestic oil, natural gas, coal, shale, tar sands, wind, biofuels, nuclear, solar, ocean tides, batteries, fuel cells and hydrogen energies. “The day we commit to all of these technologies is the day the Terrorists start losing, squeezed by shrinking revenues and hungry followers,” he says. When it comes to solving the immigration issue, Sid suggests English should be the official language, the borders

must be secure, and ID cards for all non-citizens are essential. Social Security benefits, Sid insists, should start at age 75—not 65. He urges young people to exercise their right to vote as often as they vote for the next *American Idol* winner.

Unlike most political books is the fact that Dinerstein casts no blame for what ails our nation.

“People are always telling me to run for office,” Dinerstein clarifies. “I decided to write a book instead... It’s all about the children. We need to grow up before *they* do.”
